


Printing and Saving from your PDF viewer

The monthly Rambler, as well as the PDFs of the guides such as this one, will either appear in your browser's PDF viewer or your browser will load a reader such as Adobe Acrobat or Foxit.

Chrome

You may not see any **Print** or **Save / Download** icons near the top of the viewer's screen



but, if you move the mouse cursor towards the top the icons will appear

You can change the name of the file from *Latest-Rambler* to, for example, *December Rambler* before saving it.

You can also choose where you save it



You can choose a page [2], a range of pages [2-5] or a number of pages [2,3,7,12] to print.

At the side of the screen are icons which enable you to adjust the image size



Microsoft Edge

You'll have to click near the top to bring up the icons

The icons which enable you to adjust the image size are at the top of the screen

Internet Explorer and Safari

These two browsers use your default reader, probably Adobe Acrobat, to show PDFs
The icons will appear towards the bottom of the screen.

Firefox

You will be asked to choose the reader you wish to use - again this will probably be Adobe Acrobat.
Once the PDF has been loaded you will be able to Print or Save using this reader.
